**Unified Support Pathways** provides a consistent and thorough approach to supporting students with specific barriers to learning.

Each of our three pathways is designed to equip all students with the support they need to thrive in school both in and out of the classroom.

The following support will be in place for all students on any of our pathways:

- *A Pupil Passport to communicate to school staff the specific needs of your child including specific reasonable adjustments and provisions.*
- *One to one student check-ins with a key member of staff at least once a term to review what is working well and set targets for the following term.*
- *Online parents evenings six times a year. This is an opportunity to share any information with us that may be helpful, discuss how your child is getting on, the provision in place or any concerns you may have.*

## PASSPORT PATHWAY

Focus on adaptive teaching and reasonable adjustments in the classroom shared through Pupil Passport.

## REFRESH PATHWAY

Focus on significant targeted interventions to support engagement in the classroom, attendance to school and mental health.

## BESPOKE PATHWAY

Focus on significant interventions or changes to provision in school to prevent exclusion and to support access to the school environment.

*The intent behind the refresh and bespoke pathways is to target specific, fixed term interventions to support students back onto the Passport Pathway.*

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## **Q) Is the pathway my child is on set in stone?**

A) No, the pathways are regularly reviewed in line with the provisions and interventions in place.

## **Q) Who will be my child's key person?**

A) This will be linked into their specific needs, for example our Autism champion will be the key person if there is an autism diagnosis.

## **Q) If I think my child's passport need amending who do I speak to?**

A) Please contact the send team on [send@mce.hlt.academy](mailto:send@mce.hlt.academy) or attend one of our open days and we would be more than happy to talk through the passport with you.

## **Q) Which interventions will be in place for my child?**

A) Interventions, provision and reasonable adjustments are made depending on the specific needs of the child. Interventions in place will be communicated to you via EduKey.

## **Q) My child is on the Passport Pathway and I think they should be on a different pathway, what should I do?**
